The Administrator's Credential

This course provides the additional 60 hours of director's training towards achieving the Administrator's Credential. **Director's Academy training is required to register for the Administrator's credential.**

"The NJ Administrators' Credential Technical Assistance Manual was released in September 2009 and is recommended for all administrator and supervisors who support professionals working with children birth through age thirteen... The credential is recognized by the National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC) in the alternate pathways to achieve educational qualifications of the program administrator.

The credential includes:

- 120 hours training (60 hours Directors' Academy + 60 hours Administrator's credential)
- Practicum courses (total of 3) for a total of 24 hours
 - PAS – Program Administration Scale for 4 hours
 - PIP+ - Program Improvement Plan for 10 hours
 - PRF – Professional Resource File for 10 hours
